

The St George Blue Light Disco and the St George Buffalo Lodge have formed a partnership to assist in the education of school children with regards to road safety.

Every year the St George Buffalo Lodge donates two bicycles with helmets to the St George Blue Light. These bikes are supplied locally by Golders St George.

Throughout the year the St George police actively patrol the local school zones to identify children adopting correct road safety techniques such as crossing at School crossings, wearing bicycle helmets and walking on footpaths. These children are then issued with Road Safety awards and their name is taken for entry into the draw to win a bicycle.

For those children not displaying correct road safety behaviours, police provide guidance to the students.

To reinforce the road safety message, the local Adopt a Cops attend the schools to provide further information.

Every six months at the Blue Light Disco, the draw is run for the bicycle competition and a lucky child within the community will win a bike with helmet.

One lucky winner was Mia Guild (pictured right) of St Patricks School, who in a moving act of generosity decided that since she already had a bike she wanted a re-draw.

The **new** lucky winner was Jayedeenia Doyle from St George State School. This being Jayedeenia's first bike, she was of course thrilled!

The bike was presented to her at Golders by Fred Bradley on behalf of the Buffalo Lodge.
